I also function as a voting member of the Forensic Review Committee, which offers opinions to the Hospital Administration regarding changes in status of criminally committed patients. I also act as a supervisor for other Forensic Examiners at Fulton State Hospital, providing supervision of

cases, instruction, and administrative duties. I also act as a supervisor in Fulton State Hospital's Predoctoral Internship. I also provide seminars and training to clinical staff and interns on assessment, malingering, forensic issues, and psychopathology.
